







High Performance Pagwood

Pagwood is a composite material made from natural beechwood veneers soaked in specially developed synthetic resins and fused under 500 tons of pressure at a temperature of 250 degrees celsius, creating a material that is highly resistant to impact, moisture and chemicals. Pagwood is extremely durable.

Pagwood darkens a tone after extended exposure to the sun resulting in a natural patina that enhances the character of the natural wood. Pagwood is a LEED certified wood.

When solid wood is used for outdoor furniture, it moves, cracks, fades and becomes brittle. Pagwood contains the beauty of natural wood with none of the natural wood draw backs.
