What's New

This month, we highlight some products that can contribute points to the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) rating system.

SS Credit 4.2 Alternate Transportation: Bicycle Storage, Changing Rooms

Standard Racks – 38 Different Styles including round and square tube in galvanized, powder coated, rubber dipped and stainless steel.

Custom Racks – 62 custom hitch, hoop and designer bicycle racks—or create your own.

Bicycle Lockers – Modular, rectangular and irregular shaped lockers

Bicycle Shelters – 3 Styles. Store six bicycles in less than 32 square feet.

Bicycle Storage System – 4 different storage systems with freestanding, wall or ceiling mounted installation options for office, multi-family housing and bike station applications.

MR Prerequisite 1: Storage and Collection of Recyclables Required

Recycling Containers – 11 different styles including custom configurations. Recycle bottles, cans, newspaper, plastics, paper and trash. Single and multiple function, interior and exterior applications.

SS Credit 5.2 Site Development: Maximize Open Space

SS Credit 7.1 Heat Island Effect: Non-Roof

Umbrellas – 10 models including 3 cantilevered styles that can be rotated for maximum shade protection. 7 models with secure surface mounted installation options for use in light to moderate wind. Sizes from 7–20 feet.

Shade Shelters – 7 styles of Arbors, Colonnades, Gazebos, Hexagonal, Octagonal and Square shade structures in standard and built to suit sizes and designs.

Green Collaboration

Ellis Elementary School, Denver, was selected by the Earth Day Network for a “Green Makeover” as a part of the Earth Day 2008 celebration.



The makeover included installation of a 1.6 kw Adobe Solar System, plants for a green roof, bike racks (provided by Streetscapes), a greenhouse and a host of other green elements.
